



Space Saving Solutions

If you only have a small space to work with, there are lots of “tricks of the trade” to consider, which will allow a small bathroom to feel spacious and work functionally. The ensuite bathroom is often the smallest bathroom in the house but can also be the most frequently used. It is important to get the design right! Here are some ideas to consider:

- Use light coloured tiles and fixtures to keep the bathroom looking bright, creating a more spacious feel.
- Use large size tiles to reduce the number of grout lines, making the bathroom appear “less busy”.
- Don’t forget to pay attention to great lighting – not only will it show off your bathroom’s features but the lighter and brighter the bathroom, the more spacious it will feel.
- Use natural light wherever possible to open up a small bathroom space.
- Consider large mirroring to increase the visual space of the bathroom.
- Wall hung vanities, or vanities raised on feet to expose the floor underneath give the illusion of greater space.
- Wall hung toilets with concealed cisterns also give the illusion of greater space.
- Ensure you are allowing adequate storage space to avoid a cluttered bathroom on a day to day basis.
- Consider using the space in the wall cavity to create recessed shelving.
- The reflective property of glass increases the visual perception of small spaces – consider a frameless shower screen for this purpose.
